April 2015 Tips and Tricks: IOF - Managing Jobs

Here are a few "tips and tricks" that can simplify your review and management of jobs under IOF.

From any ISPF screen, to display all jobs matching the specified job name:

=i.batjob3

=i.bat*

If your system uses something other than the "I" option to invoke IOF, just specify that option instead of "I":

=x.y.batjob3

=x.y.bat*

From any IOF display:

To switch to a display of all jobs matching the specified job name:

j batjob3 5801 Pelican Bay Blvd., Suite 300, Naples, FL 34108

j bat*

To switch to a display of job number 12345: **job 12345**

To display a selection menu for jobs: j

From the *IOF Job Summary* for a job or when browsing the sysout for a job:

ex c/r Exit IOF and cancel/release the current job's output

ret c/r Return to IOF Job List and cancel/release the current job's output

Note that you must specify EX (not EXIT) and RET (not RETURN).
